**Historic Restoration: \$35,000 to \$75,000**

As a Remodeler, some projects are just a privilege to be a part of - and this Historic Preservation in Bradfordville is just that.

Originally built in the 1920's at the present site of the bus station, our client purchased this home in the early 1980's to save it from the landfill, and relocated it to 10 acres in then sparsely populated Bradfordville.



Our challenge was to start the process of full restoration to its original state. With the owner, we decided to concentrate on the "bones" of the home - a new roof with added strapping, removal and recycling of the vinyl siding, replacement simulated divided light windows, the removal of a never used fireplace that was pulling away from the home, and floor refinishing.

As we removed the vinyl siding, heart pine siding was exposed - and with some patching and repairs, its condition was surprisingly impressive.
